

The mission of the H.O.P.E. organization is to provide emergency assistance to those in need, and to give them the tools and resources that promote self-sufficiency by pooling resources that provide assistance through a networking system designed to prevent duplication of services.

We serve many community members each month in our **Manna Pantry**. Our pantry has been redesigned to emphasize nutrition, healthy food choices, and give our neighbors the dignity of selecting their own food.



In an effort to combat childhood hunger, we created our **Backpack Program**. We provide a backpack full of food, every weekend of the school year to children in the Jacksonville Independent School District.



HOPE meets the needs of local Seniors through our **Senior Box Program**. Our program provides them with a box of food to help them through the month. Each box contains easily prepared foods selected to support the needs of aging adults.



We serve a hot homemade meal Monday - Thursday 11:45 am thru 12:30 pm in our **Kitchen of HOPE**. Lunch is provided at no cost and everyone is welcome.



Our **Brown Bag Program** is designed to help those in need of food, who are homebound, and without access to our Manna Pantry.



We provide assistance to neighbors in need of antibiotics through our **Emergency Prescription Program**.



Programs

With the cost of prescriptions sky rocketing, HOPE tries to fill in the gap by helping our uninsured neighbors obtain recurring prescriptions at low or no cost. Our **Prescriptions Application Assistance Program** helps provide essential medication.



Living in Cherokee County, a car is a necessity. Our **Transportation Program** aims to ease the burden caused by a lack of personal or public transportation. We transport our neighbors to run essential errands.



We not only provide for our clients' physical needs but emotional needs as well. This year we formed a **Support Group**, facilitated by a licensed counselor, to help those feeling overwhelmed.



Learning is a life long endeavor. Our **Life Enrichment Classes** aspire to give our neighbors the building blocks to lift themselves out of their current circumstances.



Job Fair of HOPE is a monthly visit from an employer or staffing agency looking to hire on the spot. This is a one "stop shop" from the interview, to drug testing and leaving gainfully employed. We aim to remove all barriers to finding employment.



Oral health plays a major role in overall health. Our **Dental Program** helps our neighbors with severe dental issues and no insurance see a dentist, free of charge.



Ernest came to HOPE in extreme pain caused by a dental emergency. Our Emergency Dental Program in partnership with All Smiles, pulled over 20 teeth.



Susie frequents our Manna Pantry and receives her Senior Box at HOPE. We are ecstatic to help her meet her nutrition needs.
